Whereas, Vermonters concerned about the State's youngest residents will gather at the State House on March 11, 2020 to discuss with their State legislators the importance of early childhood care, including affordability, health care, and education-associated components, now therefore be it

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives:

That the General Assembly designates Wednesday, March 11, 2020 as the 26th Early Childhood Day at the State House, and be it further
