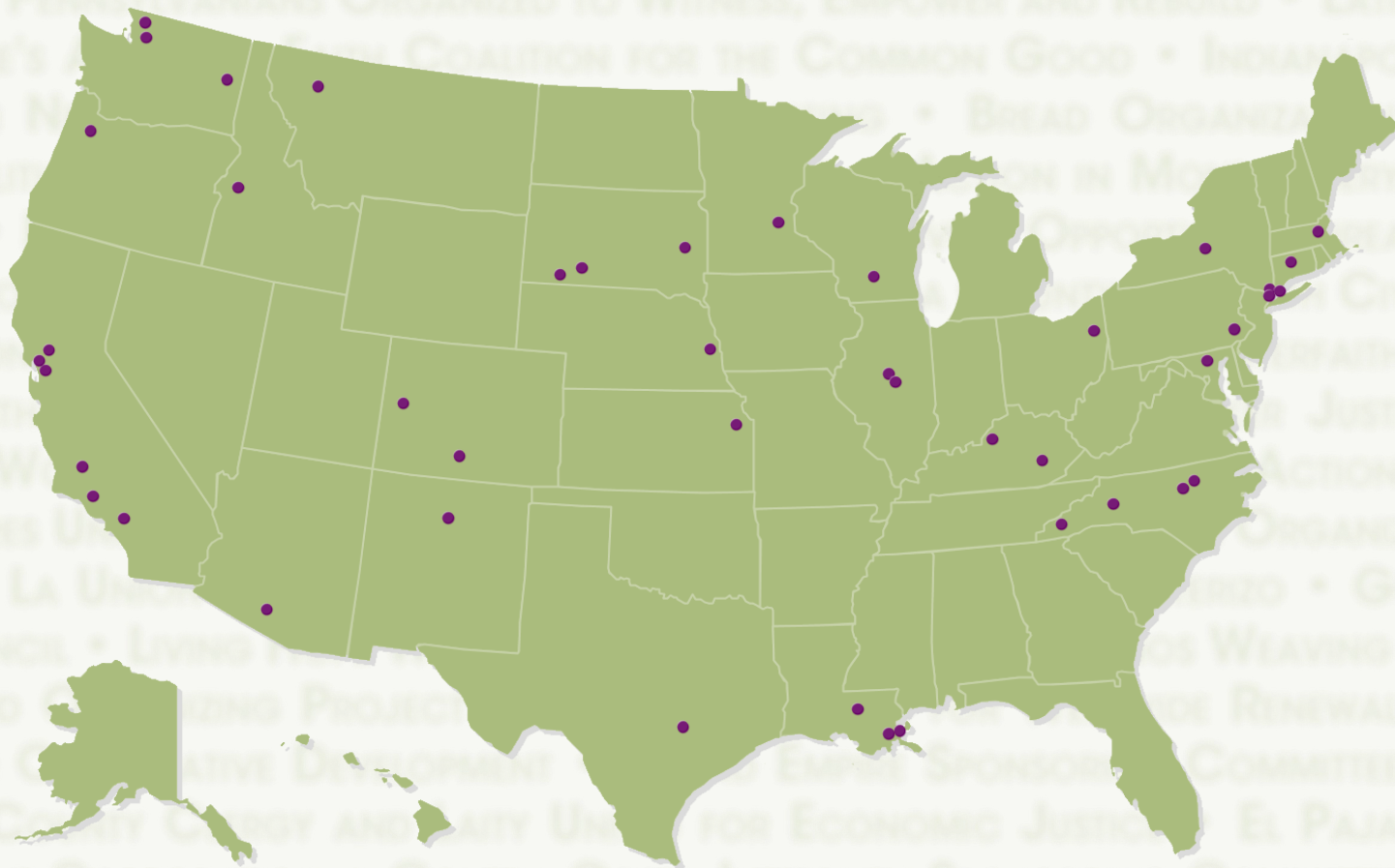

# THE CATHOLIC CAMPAIGN FOR HUMAN DEVELOPMENT CARES FOR GOD'S CREATION

- Between 2013 and 2016, the Catholic Campaign for Human Development has invested over **3.2 million** dollars to support the care for God's creation.
- **71 grants** were awarded to **45 groups** to support community organizing and economic development initiatives through grassroots organizing, capacity building, education for workers, economic empowerment, and advocacy.
- Over **35 dioceses** are working with CCHD sponsored organizations addressing environmental justice.
- **Community Organizing** and **Economic Development** initiatives supported by the Catholic Campaign for Human Development are addressing the issues of water pollution, air pollution, sustainable agriculture, extractives, urban gardening and healthy food, community development and protection, energy efficiency, and green jobs.
- Community-based organizations funded by the Catholic Campaign for Human Development are protecting their environment and making economic empowerment a reality for low-income communities through **green jobs** and **energy efficiency**.
- The CCHD supports grassroots organizations working for environmental justice across **25 states**.
