## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the repeal of the temporary tax reduction for certain
- 3 high-cost gas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 81.117(d), Natural Resources Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The exemptions and reductions set out in Sections
- 8 201.053, [201.057,] 201.058, and 202.060, Tax Code, do not affect
- 9 the fee imposed by this section.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 201.057, Tax Code, is repealed.
- 11 SECTION 3. (a) Subject to Subsection (b) of this section,
- 12 the change in law made by this Act does not affect tax liability
- 13 accruing before the effective date of this Act. That liability
- 14 continues in effect as if this Act had not been enacted, and the
- 15 former law is continued in effect for the collection of taxes due
- 16 and for civil and criminal enforcement of the liability for those
- 17 taxes.
- 18 (b) The tax reduction provided by Section 201.057, Tax Code,
- 19 as repealed by this Act, does not apply to gas produced on or after
- 20 the effective date of this Act, regardless of whether the
- 21 comptroller approved a tax reduction under Section 201.057 that
- 22 would have applied to the gas on or after the effective date of this
- 23 Act had Section 201.057 not been repealed.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
