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NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the orders of the Public Regulation Commission at issue in this consolidated appeal are AFFIRMED and the Community Solar Rule is upheld;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an opinion shall follow setting forth the Court's reasoning.
