

Are you looking for land to start or expand your farming operation? Follow these 4 easy steps to get started!



Oregon Farm Link (OFL) is an online hub that provides a platform for beginning farmers and land holders to connect.

LOOKING FOR LAND TO FARM?

STEP 1. CREATE A USER PROFILE

Visit www.oregonfarmlink.org and hover your cursor over "Account" on the right side of the screen. Select "Sign Up."



STEP 2. MAKE A LAND SEEKER LISTING



Once you have your user profile, you're now ready to create a Land Seeker Listing. Make sure you are logged in then hover your cursor over the "Land Seekers" menu and select "Create Land Seeker Listing." Fill out all required fields and select "Submit." You will receive an email once your listing is approved by our staff.

STEP 3. FIND A LAND LISTING!

You can now go to OFL and search for the perfect Land Listing to start or expand your operation. Make sure you are logged in, hover your cursor over the "Land Seekers" menu and select "Search Land." You can select specific categories or leave the search fields blank to browse through all the listings.

STEP 4. CONTACT A LAND HOLDER

When you find a Land Holder you are interested in, use the email address shown on the bottomright of the screen to contact them. Be sure to include a link to *your* Land Seeker Listing--this allows them to read more about you and your experience or intentions in the listing you created.
