THIS BILL WOULD SET UP A NEW RECOVERY TASK FORCE TO DIRECT ASSISTANCE WHERE IT WILL REACH THE MOST IMPACTED COMMUNITIES.

IT WOULD ALSO CREATE A NEW PROGRAM TO FUND LOWER-COST HOUSING FOR PEOPLE NEAR OR BELOW THE MEDIAN INCOME, ENSURING DISPLACED FAMILIES HAVE A SAFE AND AFFORDABLE PLACE TO CALL HOME.
