## Teach-Learn-Connect Series

The Nuclear Communities Technical Assistance team is hosting a Community of Practice (Teach-Learn-Connect Series) to bring together communities from across the country for a series of conversations around ideas, experiences, and resources that contribute to the longterm economic, social, and environmental resilience of nuclear host communities and regions.

The Nuclear Communities TA team strives to support host communities in ways that are meaningful and productive; each community's experience has been unique, but we believe that there is immense value in establishing a space to talk and think through these issues with other folks who might understand them more than anyone else, in their own context. These conversations are meant to serve as a space for local leaders and economic development officials to build relationships with their counterparts from peer communities and collaborate on long-term planning approaches for their municipality and region. By establishing this network, we also intend to amplify the national conversation around economic transition and resilience in the particular context of nuclear plant decommissioning - we are looking forward to supporting local leaders and practitioners as they shape the narrative and set a guiding footprint for nuclear host communities across the country.
