



60% of Arizona counties are at high risk for a measles outbreak.

High rates of exemptions from immunization put MMR coverage levels* in these counties below the 95% needed for community immunity.



Non-medical^{**} exemption rates increased from **2017** to **2018**, and were more than **4 times higher** than they were in **2000**.



Only **4 in 10** kindergarten classrooms have the coverage levels necessary to stop a measles outbreak.

This means over **5,000** Arizona kindergarteners would be at risk for measles.



Personal Belief Exemption rates are higher in public **non-district (charter)** and **private** schools than in public **district** schools.





*All coverage and exemption rates were obtained from the Arizona Immunization Data Reports for child care, kindergarten, and 6th grade.

**Non-medical exemptions refer to children who are not immunized due to parental religious (child care) or other personal (K-12) beliefs.
