The Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals has ruled that DACA is unlawful.

Tell Congress to protect Dreamers now!



Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) is an immigration policy that allows some undocumented immigrants, who were brought to the United States as children, to receive a two-year renewable period of deferred action from deportation and to be eligible for an employment authorization document (work permit) in the U.S.

On July 16, 2021, a U.S. district court judge ruled that DACA violated the law and barred the government from accepting new applications to the program; however, current recipients can keep their status and submit renewals while the case goes through the appeals process. On October 5, 2022, the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals affirmed that DACA is unlawful.
