WHAT IS THE DELEGATES ASSEMBLY?

- JCPA members voted in April 2018 to replace the Plenum with the Delegates Assembly as part of our new governance structure.
- The Delegates Assembly will set and help carry out the community relations field's public policy positions and priorities, as well as vet emerging issues.

SO WHAT'S DIFFERENT?

PLENUM AND BOARD

- 100+ member Board oversees and carries out policy work, with only 30 lay community reps
- Board also oversees governing and fiduciary matters

DELEGATES ASSEMBLY

- Every JCRC and national agency has two reps: one professional and one lay rep
- Delegates Assembly is responsible for setting and carrying out JCPA's public policy work
- Delegates meet 2-3 times a year
- Small Board only oversees governing and fiduciary matters

- Participate in JCPA policy briefings
- Build strong relationships with state and federal elected officials and keep lines of communication open for national strategy and advocacy efforts
- Engage in advocacy and help mobilize your community in local and national activities

COMMUNICATIONS

- Build rapport with local Jewish papers and Federation communications team to ensure local communities know about:
 - -JCPA's education and advocacy opportunities
 - -Local participation in JCPA's national activities
 - -Advertise JCPA's programs and webinars
- Recruit local leaders to JCPA's national conferences
- Regularly update JCPA on local activities and programs
