AN ACT

To amend chapter 569, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the offense of trespass by an illegal alien, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 569, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 569.087, to read as follows:

569.087. 1. A person commits the offense of trespass by an illegal alien if the person:

- 3 (1) Is present on public or private land in this state; and
 - (2) Is not carrying the person's alien registration card, is not a temporary resident, is not a temporary visitor, or has willfully failed to register.
- 6 2. The offense of trespass by an illegal alien is a class E felony.
- 7 3. The provisions of this section shall not apply to a person who maintains 8 authorization from the federal government to remain in the United States.
 - 4. As used in this section, the following terms mean:
- 10 (1) "Alien registration card", the identification card given to lawful permanent 11 residents by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services to identify them as 12 such;
- 13 (2) "Illegal alien", an alien who is not lawfully present in the United States, 14 according to the terms of 8 U.S.C. Section 1101, et seq.
