HB 37	REP D MCCORMICK	Removes the requirement that a person possess a permit issued by the state of LA in order to carry a concealed handgun.	Pending House Administration of Criminal Justice	SUPPORT
HB 80	REP R EDMONDS	Conservative method of planning state budget. Limits proposed expenditures to 98% of projected revenue.	Pending House Appropriations	SUPPORT
