#### 6) Technical Committee Update

- a) Pesticide Applicator Updates Kim shared that he has pursued the core and cat 6 training. Kim is putting notes together on the process and his experience.
  - i) SWCD will/can make books available for use in pursuit of the certification or just for your own review/education.
  - ii) Volunteers do not have to have pesticide applicator licensing to apply herbicide (except on school properties where there much be a licensed individual) BUT it is a good training and good practice to have some HIP members licensed. Contact Dorrie, Kim, or Mary for more info.
- b) Strike team- The Strike Team is our own HIP invasive management team. This is separate from volunteer/education workdays. This group is more targeted to go in and complete targeted management. The first event is March 20<sup>th</sup> 9am-4pm at Riverside A second worksite has been identified: Fall Creek Township Natural Area
