

## APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO RACIAL EQUITY TASK FORCE

#### **General Information**

The State of Vermont seek applicants to serve on a Task Force focused on advancing racial equity. The Task Force will be advisory to the Governor through May 31, 2021, or as extended by the Governor.

Application Period: Friday June 5, 2020 to Friday June 12, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.

Meetings will begin in early- to mid-June 2020.

## **Eligibility**

To qualify as a member of the Racial Equity Task Force you must:

- Be a resident of the state of Vermont, and
- Be able to participate in web-based meetings

#### **About the Task Force**

The Task Force is directed to

- Evaluate structures of support for racially diverse populations, particularly in light of the
  disparities in health outcomes highlighted by COVID-19. These structures of support include,
  but may not be limited to, existing supports in Vermont, potential policy changes, tools and
  resources both for individuals and for the state & local governments, language access,
  economics, housing, health care, and access to credit;
- Review current state and federal law on hate speech and freedom of speech, and consider
  potential changes to state law regarding speech and display of racially inflammatory symbols
  in venues receiving state funds;
- Study and present options for encouraging Vermonters from diverse, marginalized, or underrepresented racial and ethnic groups to run and serve in public office at all levels (local, state [including boards and commissions], and federal).
