

The Annual Convention Art Exhibit and Contest

During the Annual Convention, The Arc of Illinois hosts an Art Exhibit and Contest. This year, the Annual Convention will be hybrid with both virtual and in-person attendees.

The Art Exhibit will be displayed:

- **Virtually** on the Annual Convention microsite, Wednesday, April 12th through Thursday, April 20th; and
- **In-person** at the DoubleTree in Lisle, IL Wednesday, April 19th & Thursday, April 20th.

All Artists must submit a picture of their artwork for the virtual exhibit. Artists are welcome to have their work displayed at the Convention, if able, but is not a requirement to participate in the contest. Below is some information on the Art Exhibit and Contest. Complete contest rules will be emailed to the artists upon receiving the submission below.

- Artwork must be a 2D original piece completed by an individual or groups of individuals with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities.
- If displaying in-person, the piece must be mounted on a firm rigid surface for easy placement on an easel.
- Limit one piece per artist or group.
- Artists have the option of donating their original piece to The Arc of Illinois Silent Auction.
- All artists will receive a certificate and honorable mention ribbon. Judging for first, second, and third place will be open April $12^{th} 20^{th}$, with the winners receiving first, second, or third place ribbons.
