Democracy is based on the principle that all individuals have equal value and should have equal rights and opportunities.

The John R. Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act (VRAA) seeks to restore and strengthen portions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965 that the U.S. Supreme Court struck down or weakened.

VRAA would return the Voting Rights Act to full strength by holding states accountable when they attempt to disenfranchise voters and restore voters' ability to challenge discriminatory changes to voting practices.

Named in honor of civil rights icon and U.S. Congressman John R. Lewis, the act has been the subject of extensive debate in Congress. The legislation is essential to protect the voting rights of marginalized communities and ensures that all Americans have an equal voice in the democratic process.
